Funeral & Burial Assistance

The loss of a loved one is difficult, and the costs of burial or cremation can create an additional burden. Below is regional guide of resources that may help families navigate assistance options.

National Assistance

Social Security

- Survivors should contact Social Security as soon as possible or provide the Social Security Number to the funeral director, who will notify the agency.
- A surviving spouse or eligible child may receive a lump-sum payment of \$255.
- Ongoing monthly benefits may be available for certain family members.

Veterans Benefits

- The U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs (VA) may cover a portion of funeral and burial costs, depending on service and circumstances of death.

Kentucky

Kentucky does not offer a statewide funeral assistance program, but some counties provide up to \$1,000 in aid. Families should contact their local coroner's office for eligibility.
